DISPOSAL DIRECTORY -

FIX-IT CLINIC

Instead of tossing items there is a fix-it clinic in Washington County. Check the website for further information – WashCoRecycles.com/Fixit (651-27507475) First come, first serve – LIMIT 3 ITEMS.

TIPS TO RECYCLE RIGHT

Put items loose into your home recycling – do not use plastic bags.

Rinse all containers. OK to leave caps on.

Empty and flatten cardboard boxes.

Search the Disposal Directory if you are not sure about an item.

ITEMS ACCEPTED IN YOUR CURBSIDE RECYCLING CART

Newspaper and inserts

Magazines and catalogs

Mail and office papers.

Cereal and cracker boxes

Cardboard boxes

CARTONS

Milk and juice cartons.

Soup, broth, and wine cartons.

Juice boxes

GLASS BOTTLES AND JARS

Glass food and beverage bottles and jars

PLASTIC BOTTLES AND CONTAINERS

Containers numbered 1, 2 or 5.

Soda, juice and water bottles

Milk and juice jugs.

Margarine, cottage cheese, cream cheese and other tubs and lids

Dishwashing and laundry detergent bottles and jugs

Clear bottles and produce containers.

Yogurt, pudding and fruit cups

ITEMS NOT ACCEPTED IN YOUR CURBSIDE RECYCLING CART

Batteries

Containers that contained paint, used oil, antifreeze and other hazardous products.

Diapers

Dishes, vases and mirrors

Electronics

Foil pouches, bags, and wrappers.

Needles and syringes

Paper cups, plastic straws and utensils

Personal protective equipment (PPE)

Pipes, clothes hangers, pots, pans, and other scrap metal.

Plastic bags, bubble wrap, and other plastic film

Propane and fuel tanks

Ropes, hoses, chains, string lights and other items that may tangle.

Shredded paper, wrapping paper, or tissue paper.

Do not bag recyclables.

There are events throughout the year in the area where you can recycle items, which will be on the city and county website.

FOOD SCRAP PROGRAM IN WASHINGTON COUNTY

You may use a compost pile for food scraps on your property or obtain a compost bin from Washington County. Check the county website at washcorecycles.com/barrels to purchase compost bins or rain barrels.

If you wish to recycle food scraps you can order your free supply of food scrap bags at foodscrapspickup.com (651-661-9393), collect food scraps in the bags and when the bag is full, tie a knot at the top to close the bag and place it inside your trash container for collection. Your trash is collected as usual, and the bags are sorted from the trash and composted.

MEDICINE RECYCLING

The medicine can be dropped off at the Mahtomedi Library or Stillwater Law Enforcement Center 15015 62nd St. N. Stillwater, MN in the main lobby.

The medication is anonymous, so you do not need to remove labels, keep medication in original container, if you don't have the original container – place medication in a small bag.
